The California Department of State Hospitals (DSH) – Napa opened on November 15, 1875. The state hospital's current treatment philosophies, rooted in the moral treatment concept of the late 1800s, have reflected the numerous prevailing practices over the decades. DSH – Napa is moving toward the next century with a bio-psychosocial rehabilitation philosophy for the treatment of patients. The state hospital's specialized programs treatment services meet national standards the and set bv Joint Commission (JC). It is certified under the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and licensed by the Department of Health Services for three levels of care including Acute Psychiatric, Skilled Nursing Facility, and Intermediate Care Facility. DSH – Napa is classified as a low to moderate security facility and has a bed capacity to treat up to 1,362 patients on an attractive campus with its treatment units located on 138 acres. DSH - Napa creates an atmosphere where patients, state hospital staff, volunteers, family members, and community mental health staff work together to offer new ideas and make choices and decisions regarding the quality and type of services provided.
