A public meeting will be held to discuss and develop guidelines for education and training standards for Department of State Hospitals psychiatrists and psychologists under Assembly Bill 1962 (Chapter 405, Statutes of 2016). This bill requires DSH to consult with the Judicial Council of California and groups or individuals representing judges, defense counsel, district attorneys, counties, advocates for people with developmental and mental disabilities, state psychologists and psychiatrists, professional associate and accrediting bodies for psychologists and psychiatrists, and other interested stakeholders in the development of guidelines regarding minimum education and training standards for psychiatrists and psychologists to be considered for appointment by the court to conduct evaluations of defendants' mental competence. The public meeting will give stakeholders an opportunity to provided recommendations for these guidelines.

A copy of the agenda will be posted to the DSH website. All items on the agenda will be under discussion. However, items may not be added to the agenda after provision of notice unless an emergency exists that meets the criteria in Government Code 11125.3. Items raised by the public that are not on the agenda cannot be addressed at that meeting but must be noticed for a future meeting.
