**NOTICE OF DELETION OR REPRINTING
FOLLOWING EXPIRATION OF EMERGENCY
REGULATORY ACTION**

OAL Matter Type: Emergency (E)

Pursuant to section 11346.1 of the Government Code, you are hereby notified that the adoption of regulations made by the above-described emergency regulatory action expired on February 20, 2021 and were repealed by operation of law 303 days from their April 23, 2020 effective date (180 days for the initial emergency period plus 60 days pursuant to Executive Order N-44-20 plus an additional 60 days pursuant to Executive Order N-71-20). This repeal occurred because the regulatory adoption process was not completed, and the rulemaking file was not submitted to the Office of Administrative Law, within the above-described effective date of the emergency regulatory action.

Notice is further given that the above-described regulations will be deleted from the California Code of Regulations pursuant to provisions of section 11346.1 of the Government Code.
